Population Media Awards 2017

The National Population Council announces the 2017 Population Media Awards to recognize coverage of population and development issues including; reproductive health, gender, education, environment, migration, urbanization, employment, population growth, family planning, and the demographic dividend among others.

Entries are invited from journalists in the print and electronic media to compete for these awards. The entries should have been aired or published in Uganda between **September 1, 2016 and August 31, 2017**. The categories include; print, television, radio, online, and the population journalist of the year.

Guidelines for Submission of Entries

- Entries should be clearly marked with entrant's name, media House, category, email address and phone contact.
- Non-English entries should be accompanied with an English translation.
- Number of submitted entries per participant should not exceed three for one category.
- Duration of submission should not exceed 5 minutes per item for electronic media entries.
- Population Journalist of the year is to be picked from entries for the other four categories. Therefore, no entry should be submitted for journalist of the year.
- Radio submissions should be on CD, and TV entries on DVD.
- Electronic media entries should include a short transcript.
- Print media submissions should clearly show name of publication and date when article was published.

- Online entries should be printed out and the posting date and URL should be clearly marked.
- Radio, TV and News Paper entries should be accompanied with an official letter from the media house.

Please Note:

- Failure to follow any of the above guidelines will lead to disqualification.
- The winners will receive their awards during the launch of the 2017 State of Uganda and World Population Reports that will be held in **November 2017**.
- The deadline for submission of entries is **5pm on October 15, 2017**.
