The purpose of this conference is to generate scientific evidence to inform policy on building a competitive Human Capital for wealth creation in a world of 8 billion.

The two-day National Demographic Dividend Conference is scheduled for **Tuesday** 25 April 2023 and Wednesday 26 April 2023, in Kampala under the theme; "BUILDING A COMPETITIVE HUMAN CAPITAL FOR WEALTH CREATION IN A WORLD OF 8 BILLION."
